So that the text she copies to the Clipboard is instantly accessible, for instance, Vikki keeps TextAloud running in her System Tray, with the options set to "Watch Clipboard," with a 1000-character minimum. She also utilizes the program's option of a 5-second delay on reading the copied text, so that if she doesn't want what she copies read aloud to her after all, she simply has to press "Cancel."

"The most valuable part about this setup is the fact that I can look at the pictures while listening to the information being read to me," adds Vikki. "It's far better than a live lecture because I can back up, pause, take notes, et cetera -- at my preferred speed, and when I need it. Because of TextAloud, I have installed flooring, doors, windows, landscaping, all of my plumbing fixtures, and installed most of them by myself!" Most satisfying of all, Vikki's repairs have turned out great, and have added immeasurably to her happiness in her new home.

Vikki has also found a variety of other helpful uses for TextAloud. "I have AD/HD and am dyslexic," she comments. "Reading, especially technical information, is very difficult for me." She adds, "I can keep it open and change the number of characters it will ignore as well, so that I can hear selected text quickly and easily." Vikki also likes the fact that she is able to keep the TextAloud tool bar 'floating' so that it's easy to play, pause, and more, as needed.

Last, but certainly not least, Vikki also turned to TextAloud to research complex medical articles and studies when dealing with two serious family illnesses over the past year.
