



TextAloud Helps Busy Author and Media Professional Make Edits -- and Meet Deadlines

Chicago-area production professional Scott Newton turned to TextAloud software as the perfect solution for editing, reviewing, and proofing his new book by ear.

In giving Scott the ability to transfer his written text into MP3 files which could then be listened to on an MP3 player, TextAloud not only assisted him with his editing, but also enabled him to do his listening flexibly, at any location. As he used the software increasingly for his book, Scott also began to utilize it regularly for proofreading other documents by ear, especially on items like e-mails and client proposals that required especially careful word choices -- and no errors.

Scott also began to use the program in his ongoing production work in unique ways as well. "I'm now starting to use TextAloud in a way that few other users have probably considered," he comments. "In my line of work, I use recorded voices quite often -- for video narration and short voice clips in multimedia or web-based



presentations. TextAloud gives me the unique ability to output high-quality audio voice files in MP3 or WAV format, and means I can easily generate a 'scratch' or 'reference' voice file before hiring a professional voice-over talent to finish the project!"

Scott's favorite voice is AT&T's 'Crystal,' whose voice is soothing, yet professional. "I'm rather amazed at the technology behind Text to Speech in the first place," he comments. "As for the quality, it really is just like having someone read to you. The quality of the TextAloud voices is fantastic."
