“In early installations of InSiteRx, nursing medication prep time was reduced by about 75%,” said Carla Corkern, Talyst CEO. “In addition, medications for new patients, or changes to an existing patient’s medications, are available to nursing staff immediately. Leading pharmacies and facility chains recognize InSiteRx as a solution that saves time while creating a safer medication process.”

With InSiteRx, opportunity for error is diminished because pharmacist-approved medications are dispensed directly before medication passes. This ensures the most current prescriptions are being administered and reduces the opportunity for human error. It also eliminates issues associated with blister packs.
